

## How to Host a Santa Fe Model Railroad Club Meeting

Nothing to it:

- 1) First, volunteer. Let the president know you wish to be a meeting host or co-host. Find a co-host and select an open date.
- 2) Then select and arrange for a meeting venue: If you don't have the space for the crowd at home, there are other places available:
  - a. Lamy Railroad & History Museum is our favored optional venue (ask Mark Kellerman to help set this up).
  - b. Whole Foods Market on Cerrillos' Community Room is free and usually available. The food has to be purchased at Whole Foods. Call the store at 992-1700 to reserve the space.
  - c. The Performance Space at La Tienda in El Dorado is available most Wednesday nights. It costs the club \$50 (the board approved a limited amount for rental for meeting spaces, but we want to keep this to a minimum).
  - d. Any space you may know of that would welcome our group (expect at most 40, mostly around 20-30).
- 3) Provide a bit of food and drink – your call on what, how much, or little.
